Main St. That is the case as a new modernized look for the franchise will take shape with a June opening planned. US Rt 20 – A total rehab and rebuild of US Rt 20 took place over 8 months under the watchful eye of ODOT. It started with the relocation of the water line (40+ years old) being relocated from the middle of US 20 to the boulevard. Then the demolition crews came in to tear out the old asphalt and four feet of concrete that was underneath. When all said & done it was worth the wait!

ODOT Will be back in 2027 to put down new pavement from where they finished this project at Burger King, and will extend to the York Township line.

In 2026 ODOT will begin another state route project in Bellevue as US Rt 18 will get new pavement from CVS south to the Hogue's grocery store.
